

Road Marking in Estonia



White continuous line

- divides traffic moving in the opposite directions;
- indicates the boundaries of traffic lanes in dangerous places;
- indicates carriageway sites on which entrance is forbidden;
- indicates borders of parking places and parking platforms;
- indicates the region of the road carriageway where the stopping and parking are forbidden;
- separates a lane intended for movement of certain vehicles.



Double white continuous line

divides traffic moves of the opposite directions on the roads with four and more lanes



White dotted line

- divides traffic moves of the opposite directions on the roads with two or three lanes;
- designates borders of lanes on the roads with two and more lanes in the same directions



White dotted line

- divides traffic moves in the opposite or same directions;
- warns about approach to the white continuous line or to the double white continuous line.



White dotted line

designates the region of the carriageway in places where the stopping and parking are permitted



White dotted line

indicates the traffic lanes within an intersection



Wide white dotted line

- marks the boundary between the acceleration or deceleration lane and the main lane of roadway;
- marks the border between a stop of passenger transports and the main lane



Double white dotted line

indicates borders of a lane on which the traffic movement can change in the opposite direction.



- divides the traffic moves in the opposite directions on the up-hills and down-hills
 - divides the traffic moves in the same direction on the roads with more than one lane;
 - designates the places intended for a U-turn, entrance or departure from parking places.
- It is permitted to cross this line from the dotted side.



Stop line

a place where the driver should stop a vehicle in the presence of the STOP sign or on the forbidding signal of a traffic light



indicates the place where drivers should stop for giving way to vehicles moving on the crossed road



Pedestrian crossing



indicates the place where the bike path crosses the roadway



Indicates the borders of artificial bumps on the road



Islands on the road.
It is not permitted the vehicles to go on the islands



specifies the directions of movement on the lanes at an intersection



Warns about approach to narrowing of the road



Warns about approach to the white continuous line

Indicates the parking zone for vehicles of the disabled people



Yellow continuous line

Indicates the part of the road where stopping and standing are not permitted



Yellow dotted line
indicates the part of the road where standing are not permitted



indicates places where standing are not permitted



Indicates places of the public transport stopping



Temporary road marking in places of a roadwork
Carries out the functions of the white continuous line



Temporary road marking in places of a roadwork
divides traffic moving in the same direction on the
road with two or more lanes
