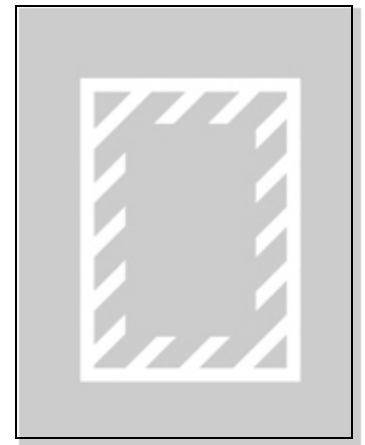
Multiple Crosswalks

Motor Vehicle Signs

These symbols are placed on or in motor vehicles so as to be visible from the front and rear of the vehicle. Each symbol identifies special consideration of the operator or passenger of the vehicles.

NEW DRIVER



This identifies the driver as a NEW DRIVER or someone with 1 year or less driving experience.

ELDERLY DRIVER



This identifies the driver as an elderly driver 70 Years of Age or older. Use of this symbol is mandatory for drivers **75 years** of age and older.

HEARING IMPAIRED



This symbol identifies the driver as hearing impaired. This driver must install an oversize rear view mirror to reduce the size of blind spots.
