# **Road Marking in Latvia**



## Continuous white line

- divides traffic moving in opposite directions;
- designates borders of lanes in dangerous places;
- marking of roads in places where enter is not permitted;
- borders of the parking places;
- the carriageway where stopping and parking are forbidden;
- separates a lane for movement of appointed vehicles.



## Double continuous white line

divides traffic moving in opposite directions on roads with four or more traffic lanes.



# Broken white line

- divides traffic moving in opposite directions on roads with two or three traffic lanes:
- divides traffic moving in the same direction on roads with two or more traffic lanes.



## Broken white line

divides traffic moving in the same or opposite directions and warns about approach to the continuous white line or double continuous white line.



## Broken white line

designates the places on road sites where the stopping and parking are permitted




## Broken white line

designates lanes within an intersection
